The Most Holy Trinity – Year A

The parish clergy: The Blessed Trinity is the origin and centre of all mysteries, and the foundation of all Christian faith and life. In it, baptism is administered in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit (cf. Mt 28.19; 2 Cor. 13.14; 1 Cor. 12.4-6; Eph. 4.4-6). It is the most fundamental and essential of all truths, but is inaccessible to reason alone. Through the history of salvation, God disclosed Himself as one God in three Persons and three Persons in one God, in order to unite us to Himself (Jn 17.21-23; 14.23). These three Persons – Father, Son, and Spirit – are equal, without any degree or disparity of substance between them. Considered in Himself, each Person is entirely God, and considered together, the three are entirely one God. Their unity is so perfect that each one is what the other is. They compenetrate each other, so that each Person is wholly in each of the other two. Although infinitely co-natural and perfectly one and undivided in their one essence and substance, the three Persons remain distinct and unconfused in their origin and Persons: the Father is not the Son or the Holy Spirit; the Son is not the Father or the Holy Spirit; and the Holy Spirit is neither the Father nor the Son; the Father begot the Son; the Son is the Sole-Begotten; while the Spirit proceeded from the Father and the Son. Yet, the three divine Persons constitute only one single principle of life and action, all things proceeding and subsisting from the Father, through the Son, in the Spirit (cf. Jn 6.44; (Rom. 8.14). (Cf. Catechism, 232-267)
