“Who are My mother and My brothers?” (Mk 3.33)

Protoevangelium – first gospel – is the term used for God's first announcement of the redemption of the human race in Christ. Following the sin of Adam and Eve, and as an eternal punishment of Satan for his role in that sin, God decreed that just as Satan's lure of a woman prompted our first parents to sin primally, a woman's offspring – Christ – would end Satan's treachery and be his ultimate undoing (Gen. 3.15). Essentially, that sin of Adam and Eve was in its form a fundamental disobedience. At the instigation of Satan, the first couple doubted the truthfulness of God and distrusted His goodness; they embraced a fundamental lie by denying their own creatureliness, wanting, rather, to be divine and to rival God; they rejected divine providence and, instead, chose to rely wholly on themselves. The result was immediate, pervasive, deep, and irreversible: their very nature and state in life became corrupted; they lost the grace of their original innocence and sanctity and became prone to evil (Rom. 3.23), the result being the deluge of the world with sin; their spiritual faculties got weakened; tension, domination, and lust entered into the relationship between man and woman; their inner harmony and their harmony with nature got ruptured; and they began to experience death, both bodily and spiritually. We call this sin, 'Original Sin', a sin that is not committed, but unavoidably contracted, by all Adam's descendants, a sin that subjected all to suffering and death (Rom. 5.12-19). It took a very long time but, at last, that sin with all its consequences was remedied through the obedience of a woman's Offspring and Adam's Descendant. (cf. CCC, 396-421) The humanity that fell from grace as a result of the disobedience of a woman with her spouse was reinstated, redeemed, and retreated through the obedience of one Man, and this all started with the total submission of one woman – Mary – to the will of God. Therefore, she is the mother of the Offspring of obedience, all who follow her example of obedience are truly brothers and sisters to Christ.
