+ WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

“Go out to the whole world, proclaim the good news.”

Usually the penultimate Sunday of October every year is the World Mission Sunday. On this day, the Church worldwide joins together in solidarity to express our ownership of the missionary mandate (Mt 28.19) given us by Our Lord. The faithful are invited to pointedly share in this mission by their ardent prayers for mission and for all missionaries, by their financial support for *missio ad gentes* (mission to the world) through the Mission Sunday collection, and by their focused attention on the possibility of God calling them to undertake this mission themselves. The efforts are channelled through the Holy See usually to the frontline where the Church is materially impoverished or fledgling and weak, or where the faith is non-existent. It enables the Church to witness in those places to God's salvific love, and to preach the gospel and call to faith those who have not heard of or embraced it. With over 80% of the world's population who are non-Christians, the task of *missio ad gentes* is both enormous and urgent and calls for all Christians to focus their energy, resources, and prayers on carrying out the missionary command to the full. Concerning this, Pope Francis reminds us that “no one is so poor as to be unable to give what they have, but first and foremost what they are.” Besides, *missio ad gentes* is today no longer confined to the boundaries of the frontline. It now also has as its legitimate targets what the Pope calls “the extreme peripheries, ‘the ends of the earth,’” that is, “human, cultural and religious settings still foreign to the Gospel of Jesus and to the sacramental presence of the Church . . . to which Jesus' missionary disciples have been sent, with the certainty that the Lord is always with them.” The “most desolate periphery of all” is “where humankind, in need of Christ, remains indifferent to the faith or shows hatred to the fullness of life in God.”
