Seventh Sunday of Easter – Year A

The parish clergy: Ten days after ascending into heaven, Our Lord Jesus fulfilled His promise to His disciples (Acts 1.8; Lk. 24.49; Jn 7.37-39; 14.15-26; 15.26; 16.7-15) by pouring out the Holy Spirit spectacularly on them (Acts 2.1-4), inaugurating the age of the Holy Spirit and of the Church. The effect was immediate and astounding. Filled and emboldened by the Spirit, and transformed by Him from being timid, ignorant, and self-centred, to being bold, fearless, eloquent, knowledgeable, and self-sacrificing, the disciples went out of hiding, began to preach and teach, to work miracles, to take on the world, and to convert thousands of people to the faith (Acts 2.41). The Holy Spirit is multifarious in His gifts and activities (1 Cor. 12.1-14.40). He is called the Paraclete, Consoler, Comforter, Advocate (Jn 14.16, 26; 15.26; 16.7); the Spirit of Truth (Jn 14.17; 15.26; 16.13), of glory (1 Pt 4.14), of adoption (Rom. 8.15); the promised Spirit (Gal. 3.14; Eph.1.13); the Living Water (Jn 4.10-14; 7.38-39; Exod. 17.1-6; Is. 55.1; Zech. 14.8; 1 Cor. 10.4; Rev. 21.6; 22.17). He is the third Person of the Blessed Trinity, being the Spirit of God the Father (Rom. 8.9, 14; 15.19; 1 Cor. 6.11; 7.40; 1 Pt. 4.14; Mt. 10.20; Lk 11.13), and of Christ, the Son, the Lord (Rom. 8.9; Gal. 4.6; 2 Cor. 3.17). He gives effect to all God's purposes. He teaches, reveals, enlightens, animates, guides, leads, transforms, heals, intercedes, supports, fortifies, defends, protects, purifies, perfects, sanctifies, vivifies, deifies. He is the breath and life of the Church and the Christian. He gives meaning, purpose, and direction to all Christian actions.
